Stokely Carmichael

- o Black Power- Pride in being African American
- Believed in violence; he alienated his group SNCC from Dr. King & SCLC
- Did not want whites to join SNCC
- Angry over events in MS (Meredith & "Walk Against Fear" in 1966)

Black Panthers

- o Oakland, CA 1966
- Founded by Huey Newton & Bobby Seale
- o Political Party
- Wanted to fight police brutality in ghettos, self-sufficiency for African Americans, full employment, & decent housing
- Against Vietnam (Dr. King agreed with this stance)
- Won support because of community programs
