For example, neonatal mortality and school dropout have been reduced particularly for some classes of women in some areas of Africa. Horticultural and agribusiness exports have grown far more rapidly in some countries than in others. These variations and many others point to opportunities for changing performance, reducing inequalities, learning from other policy experiences, and escaping the ties of structure and the legacies of a colonial past. The book rejects teleological illusions and Eurocentric prejudice but it does pay close attention to the results of policy in more industrialized parts of the world. Seeing the contradictions of capitalism for what they are fundamental and enduring may help policy officials protect themselves against the misleading idea that development can be expected to be a smooth linear process or that it would be were certain impediments suddenly removed. The authors criticize a wide range of orthodox and heterodox economists especially for their cavalier attitude to evidence. Drawing on their own decades of research and policy experience, they combine careful use of available evidence from a range of African countries with political economy insights mainly derived from Kalecki, Kaldor, and Hirschman to make the policy case for specific types of public sector investment.
