Depuis 2001, sous l'impulsion du Docteur Pierre Damon et de Dominique Wernert, le laboratoire Acoustique Wernert participe et soutient l'Ecole SE.MA.TO, à Tamatave (SEkoly MARnina TOamasina : Ecole pour Sourds de Tamatave).



Tamatave (Toamasina) est la seconde ville Malgache derrière la capitale Antananarivo. L'activité économique y est importante grâce à son port international.

L'Ecole SE.MA.TO, se situe dans un quartier défavorisé de la ville et prend en charge une soixantaine d'enfants malentendants et sourds profonds. Ces enfants sont scolarisés dès trois ans autour de la langue des signes afin d'apprendre les bases de l'enseignement pour savoir au moins lire et écrire.

Vers l'âge de 16 ans, les élèves "choisissent" un apprentissage et sont orientés vers une autre école. Les filles peuvent faire de la couture, pour les garçons c'est la menuiserie. Le choix est restreint mais leur permet malgré tout d'obtenir du travail.

Sur l'effectif complet, une vingtaine d'enfants présentant essentiellement des surdités sévères peut bénéficier de l'aide d'un appareillage auditif. Nous recyclons d'anciens contours donnés par nos patients et aussi certains contours neufs mais désuets offerts par nos fabricants (Widex, Phonak, Oticon et Siemens).

Chaque année, une mission sur place permet d'apporter petit à petit du matériel et d'assurer la continuité des appareillages auditifs.

Notre action consiste principalement à l'appareillage de nouveaux élèves, au suivi auditif des enfants mais aussi à l'entretien et au renouvellement des aides auditives.

Entre temps, les professeurs de l'école sont présents et formés pour assurer la gestion "courante" des appareils auditifs.

The Battle of Savate Piet Nortje, 2015-05-08 On 21 May 1980 under the codename Operation Tiro Tiro 32 Battalion attacked and routed a FAPLA brigade at Savate a small Angolan town 75 kilometres north of the border with South West Africa Fifteen members of 32 Battalion were killed in the action and many more wounded It was the highest South African casualty rate in a single skirmish since the start of the Border War Overall however Savate was a significant victory for 32 Battalion FAPLA suffered heavy casualties and the invaders captured a great many vehicles weapons ammunition and other equipment Operation Tiro Tiro or the Battle of Savate as it became known was the first time the SADF had engaged FAPLA in battle since 1975 And despite the record number of casualties it was 32 Battalion's biggest victory since its formation in March 1976 While the Border War came to an end in 1989 and 32 Battalion was disbanded in March 1993 to this day a remembrance service and parade is held annually on the Sunday closest to 21 May to commemorate the Battle of Savate and to remember 32 Battalion's victory and the price they paid Drawing from official documents in the Department of Defence Documentation Centre that have only recently been declassified and from testimonies of soldiers on both sides The Battle of Savate is the definitive account of one of the greatest
