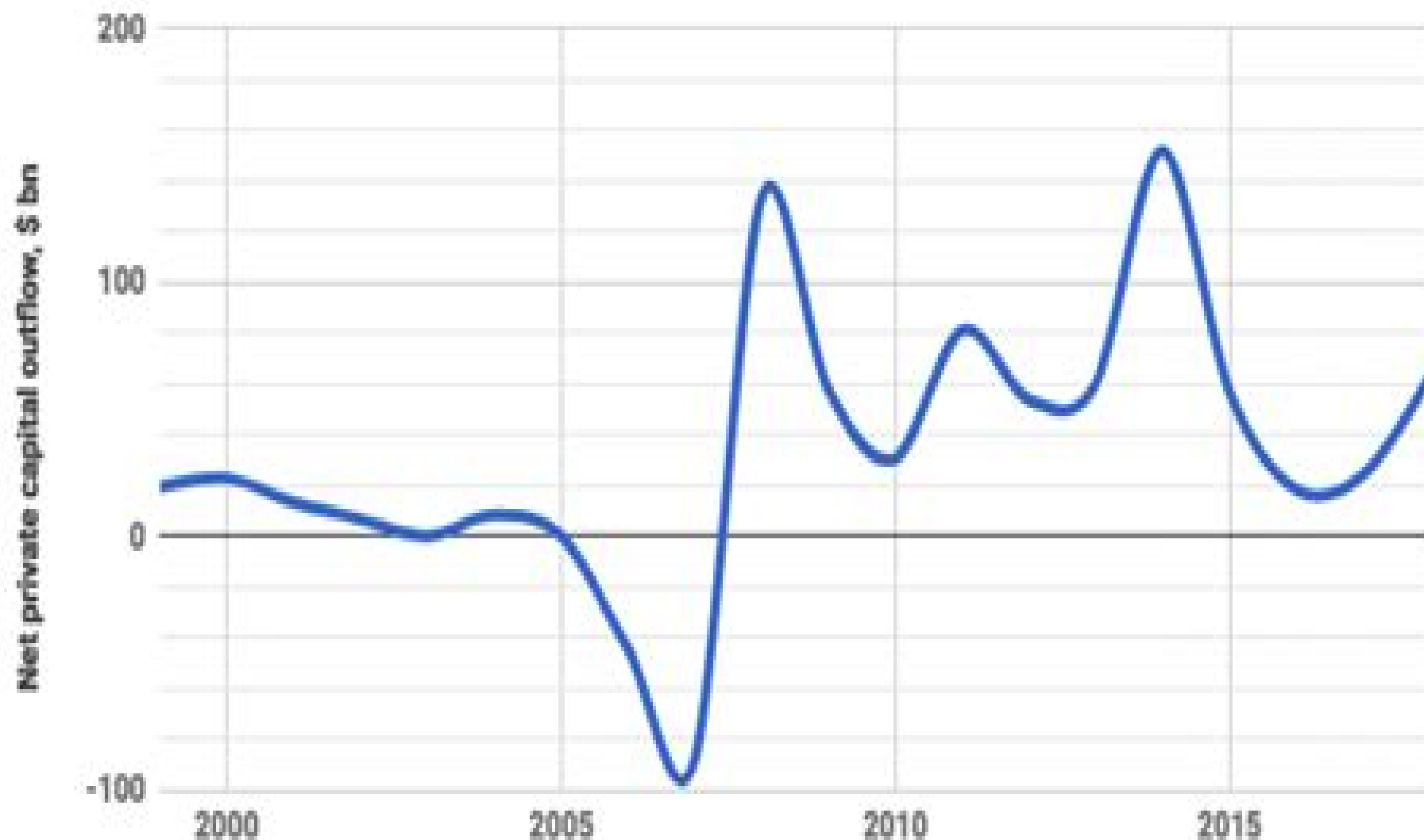


Russia net private capital outflow, \$ bn vs. Capital flight

Finally, these socialists fail to understand that without internationalism, it is impossible to defeat global capitalism and its neoliberal policies. All the case studies in this book represent attempts to carry out democratic revolutions which are supported by genuine socialist internationalists but opposed by pseudo anti-imperialists. The book ends by suggesting steps that can be taken to promote democracy and end mass slaughter.
