GEOGRAPHY

How does geography affect how a civilization develops?

The people who study history are also the people who write about history. They piece together the information they find in order to understand people from the past. Their field of study is called **historiography**.

Social scientists also use geography to study history. The book *Guns, Germs, and Steel* looks at how geography helped and hurt civilizations in the past. Jared Diamond, the book's author, explained the three factors that helped Eurasian civilizations succeed: good temperatures and locations for agriculture, resistance to certain deadly germs, and the ability to develop technology.

It is important to remember that vintage books can express attitudes and use terminology that is no longer considered appropriate. When students come across these moments in vintage books it is the perfect opportunity for them to have a discussion with their teacher about this material. Teachers and students can use this opportunity to analyze the differences in attitudes between now and then as well as to review Biblical principles regarding issues like racism. These conversations will provide students a context for understanding the attitudes expressed in the text as well as help them develop their own skills of discernment and critical thinking when it comes to materials they are reading.
