Research Dept., 2018-10-09 Global growth for 2018-19 is projected to remain steady at its 2017 level but its pace is less vigorous than projected in April and it has become less balanced. Downside risks to global growth have risen in the past six months and the potential for upside surprises has receded. Global growth is projected at 3.7 percent for 2018-19, 0.2 percentage point lower for both years than forecast in April. Meanwhile the potential for upside surprises has receded given the tightening of financial conditions in some parts of the world, higher trade costs, slow implementation of reforms recommended in the past and waning growth momentum.
