



About the backup battery

On long good time, in backup power source, the unit uses one CR2032 battery model 3V6F and its addition on the same circuit.

The battery keeps the clock and the alarm operating in the case of a power interruption.

Knowing when to replace the battery

When the battery becomes weak, "Lo" indicator appears on the display.

In the event of a power interruption, when the battery is weak, summer time and alarm function will be disabled.

Replace the battery with a new CR2032 lithium battery. Use of another battery may present a risk of fire or explosion.

Installing and replacing the backup battery

1. Remove the AC plug connected to the AC outlet, disconnect the screen that secures the battery compartment at the bottom of the unit using a screwdriver, and remove the battery compartment. (See Fig. 1-1-1)
2. Insert a new battery in the battery compartment with the (+) side facing up.
3. To remove the battery from the battery compartment, push it out from the side marked "PUSH" (see Fig. 1-1-2).
4. Insert the battery compartment back into the unit and secure it with the screen. (See Fig. 1-1-3)
5. When you are replacing the battery, press **RADIO ON** (or turn "Lo" indicator off in the display).

Notes:

- Do not replace the battery, do not disconnect AC plug from AC outlet.
- Otherwise, current time and alarm will be interrupted.

1. Press **TIME** repeatedly until the desired time appears.
2. The display returns to the clock about 1 second after the operation is complete.

Note:

During the adjustment and power first use, a clock unit may occur. In this case, refer to "Setting the clock and date" to set the correct time.

When daylight saving time (summer time) begins

- The following example is applied by the daylight saving time function. Time adjustment. The DST indicator in the display appears in the display at the beginning of the daylight saving time (summer time), and disappears at the end of it.
- Daylight saving time begins at 01:00 A.M. on the second Sunday of March.
 - Standard time begins at 01:00 A.M. on the first Sunday of November.

To cancel the Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment and to set DST display manually

The automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment can be cancelled.

Press and hold **DST** for more than 5 seconds while the clock is displayed.

A beep sounds, and "Aut. → OFF" appears in the display to show that the Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment is cancelled. The display returns to the clock.

Notes:

- The change setting of Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment can only be cancelled by the unit (cannot be adjusted or cancelled by the remote control) and the last in each country/region. In each case, cancel the Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment and set DST display mode off in country. The current date time in the country/region that has not introduced the daylight saving time (summer time) must cancel Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment before using the unit.
- To activate the Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment again, press and hold **DST** for more than 5 seconds. A beep sounds, and "Aut. → ON" appears in the display to show that the Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment is activated. The display returns to the clock.
- To change the display to the daylight saving time (summer time) manually, set "To change the display to the daylight saving time (summer time) indicator".

Setting the clock and date

To change the setting manually, follow the procedure from step 1.

1. Press **DISPON** for more than 2 seconds. The unit will turn on. A beep and the year will start to flash in the display.
2. Press **+** or **-** to set the correct year appears in the display.
3. Press **DISPON**.
4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 to set the month, day and time.

After setting the time, two short beep sound and the clock starts from 12 o'clock.

- Pressing and holding **+** or **-** changes the year, month or day setting.
- When setting the current time, time changes rapidly by 10 minutes. A beep sounds, and "Time → Off" appears in the display to show that the Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment is cancelled.
- While setting the clock, you must perform each step within 60 seconds, or the clock setting mode will be cancelled.

To display the year and date

Press **SNOOZE/DATE/SLEEP OFF** once for the clock, and within about 1 second press it again for the date.

The display shows the date or year for about 2 seconds and then changes back to the current time.

If you connect the AC plug to AC outlet while this unit is powered from the backup power source, the current date and time appears in the following order. (It is same as when the unit is powered on after the power failure.)

Year → Month → Day (about 1 second) → Year (about 1 second) → Summer time

To change the display to the daylight saving time (summer time) indication

Change the daylight saving time (summer time) adjustment within about 10 to the following procedure if you have cancelled the Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment.

Press **DST**.

DST indicator appears in the display and the time indication changes to the daylight saving time (summer time).

To deactivate the daylight saving time (summer time) adjustment, press **DST** again.

Setting the brightness of the display

Three levels of brightness are available by pressing **BRIGHTNESS**.

High (auto) → Middle → Low

Playing the radio

1. Press **RADIO-ON** to turn on the radio.
2. Adjust volume using **VOLUME**.
3. Select **BAND**.
4. Tune in to a station using **TUNING**.

To turn off the radio

Press **RADIO OFF/ALARM RESET**.

Improving the reception

FM:

The FM power cord function is an FM antenna. Extend the FM power cord fully to improve reception sensitivity.



AM:

Extend the unit horizontally to optimize reception. A better FM AM antenna is built in to the unit.



Do not operate the unit over a steel desk or metal surface, as this may lead to interference of reception.

Setting the alarm

The dual alarm function allows you to set two alarm programs (ALARM A and ALARM B). The alarm time can be set each program and the alarm sound is selectable from BUZZER or BUZZER.

Notes:

- Before setting the alarm, make sure to set the clock unit "Setting the clock and date".
- The factory setting alarm time is "7:00 (AM)".
- To set the radio alarm, first tune in to a station and adjust the volume (see "Playing the radio").
- When you set the alarm alarm, set **ALARM VOLUME** to **LO** or **HI**.

To set the alarm time

1. Set **ALARM A (or B)** to the desired alarm sound (**BUZZER** or **BUZZER**). The alarm time appears for a few seconds, and then the **ALARM A (or B)** indicator lights up in the display. (It does not appear when the switch is set to **OFF**.)
 2. Turn **ALARM TIME SET A (or B)** to **+** or **-** to set the desired time.
- Each turn of **ALARM TIME SET A (or B)** to **+** or **-** changes the indication by 1 minute. If you turn and hold **ALARM TIME SET A (or B)** to **+** or **-**, the alarm time goes forward (or backward) by 1 minute up to 10 minutes, and then by 1 minute per second. While setting the alarm time, the **ALARM A (or B)** indicator flashes in the display. The following example is when setting the **ALARM A**.



When the alarm time setting operation is complete, the display returns to the clock after a few seconds, and the **ALARM A (or B)** indicator changes from flashing to fully lit.

- While **ALARM A (or B)** is set to **RADIO** or **BUZZER**, the alarm time setting can be changed by **ALARM TIME SET A (or B)**.
- Your turn of **ALARM TIME SET A (or B)** displays the alarm time for about 2 seconds. By turning **ALARM TIME SET A (or B)** while the alarm time appears in the display, the alarm time will be changed.
- The **ALARM A (or B)** indicator flashes in the display while:
 - The alarm time appears in the display.
 - The alarm mode is turned on.
 - The alarm function is turned on.
- The alarm time setting screen is changed to **ALARM A (or B)** is set to **OFF**. If **ALARM TIME SET A (or B)** is turned, "OFF" appears in the display for about 0.5 seconds.
- If a second alarm sounds during when the alarm function is activated, the second alarm volume priority.

- **ALARM A and TIME** are interchangeable with the alarm mode in the function is turned on.
- The **ALARM VOLUME** setting works together with the beep sound volume. If the **ALARM VOLUME** is set to **LO**, the beep sound will be also set to low.
- The alarm function works as usual at the beginning and mid day of the daylight saving time (summer time). While the Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment is set, as a result, if the alarm is set at a time stopped when the daylight saving time (summer time) begins, the alarm is stopped, or if the alarm is set at a time interrupted when the daylight saving time (summer time) ends, the alarm sounds twice.
- If the same alarm time is set for both alarm, **ALARM A** and **B**, the **ALARM A** takes priority.

To close for a few more minutes

Press **SNOOZE/DATE/SLEEP OFF**.

The snooze function will set the snooze timer in again after about 10 minutes. Each time you press **SNOOZE/DATE/SLEEP OFF**, the snooze time changes as follows.

10 → 20 → 30 → 40 → 50 → 60

The maximum length of the snooze time is 60 minutes.

The display shows the snooze time for about 2 seconds and returns to show the current time. When you press **SNOOZE/DATE/SLEEP OFF** after the snooze time appears, the snooze time starts from 0 minutes again.

To stop the Alarm

Press **RADIO OFF/ALARM RESET** to turn off the alarm.

The alarm will come on again at the same time the next day.

If **RADIO OFF/ALARM RESET** is not pressed, the alarm sounds continuously for about 10 minutes, and then it will stop automatically.

To deactivate the Alarm

Turn **ALARM A (or B)** to **OFF**.

ALARM A (or B) indicator disappears from the display.

Turn on alarm in the event of a power interruption.

In the event of a power interruption, alarm function works until the battery is empty. The following functions are different.

- Display will disappear.
- When the alarm sound is set to **BUZZER**, it will change to **BUZZER** automatically.
- If the power returns while the alarm sounds, the alarm sounds continuously for about 10 minutes when the power returns.
- The alarm function for about one minute stops temporarily, and will turn again after alarm the snooze. If you press **SNOOZE/DATE/SLEEP OFF** or **RADIO OFF/ALARM RESET** are pressed while the alarm is sounding.
- If the alarm function will stop automatically after 10 minutes or by pressing **SNOOZE/DATE/SLEEP OFF**, the alarm is automatically reset in the case of a power interruption. The alarm will flash for 10 minutes after power is returned if the power is returned within 10 minutes from the alarm time.
- If you press **SNOOZE/DATE/SLEEP OFF** while the alarm sounds, snooze time is set to 10 minutes. During a power failure, snooze time cannot be set to more than 10 minutes.
- If "Lo" indicator appears in the display, the alarm will not work in the event of power interruption. Replace the battery if "Lo" indicator appears.

Setting the sleep timer

You can fall asleep to the radio using the built-in sleep timer that turns off the radio automatically after a preset duration.

Press SLEEP

The radio turns on. You can set the sleep timer to duration of 10, 15, 20, or 30 minutes. Each press changes the display as follows.



Two short beeps sound when the display returns to "OFF".

The radio will play for the duration you set, then shut off.

To turn off the radio before the preset time

Press **RADIO OFF/ALARM RESET** or **SNOOZE/DATE/SLEEP OFF**.

To use both sleep timer and alarm

The unit will shut off after the radio is turned off by the radio or timer alarm at the preset time.

1. Set the alarm. (See "Setting the alarm".)
2. Set the sleep timer. (See "Setting the sleep timer".)
