Long Sounds
/a/ in atom
/e/ in equal
/i/ in ice cream
/o/ in octopus
/u/ in unicorn

These words get coded with a **tophat**.

Digraphs

Digraphs are two letters together that make ONE sound.

in "duck"
in "leather" or
ble"
is in "ing"
is in "sheep"
as in shark
as in back or moon
as in "point"
as in "play"

These words get coded with an **underbrace**. If more codes are necessary they can be added.

ring
sheep

If the digraph has a long vowel sound then it gets a **mustache** and any letters that we don't hear get crossed out.

Suffixes

A suffix is an addition at the end of a word that adds meaning.

-er or -ers as in "cups" or "teachers" (means more than one)

-ing as in "jumping" (means happening now)

-ed as in "played" (means happened in the past and the /t/, /d/, or /ed/ sound like "tiked", "pleided")

-ly (shows what something is like)

-ous (shows something that is meany)

-ness (the state of something)

-some or something that

means (the most)

-ing full of)
