## 5 STEPS TO PERFORMING CPR

### 1 ASSESS SCENE SAFETY



Check the area for any safety hazards that may be harmful to you

### 2 CHECK FOR RESPONSIVENESS



Tap the victim's shoulder and shout, "Are you OK?"

### 3 LOOK FOR NORMAL BREATHING



Look for normal chest rise and fall

### 4 CALL 9-1-1



If no response, call 9-1-1 or your emergency responder. If you are alone, call 9-1-1 first, then perform CPR. If you are with a partner, have them call 9-1-1 while you perform CPR.

### 5 START CPR



If not breathing and no pulse, start CPR.

## ADULT

**STEPS FOR HOW TO PERFORM ADULT CPR (18 YEARS+)**

- 1. GIVE 30 CHEST COMPRESSIONS**
  - Push hard
  - Push fast
- 2. GIVE 2 RESCUE BREATHS**
  - Head-tilt, chin-lift
  - Pinch nose
  - Give 2 breaths

Repeat the cycle until help arrives, but only recommended for child and infant CPR

## CHILD

**STEPS FOR HOW TO PERFORM CHILD CPR (1 YEAR - 12 YEARS)**

- 1. GIVE 30 CHEST COMPRESSIONS**
  - Use 1 or 2 hands depending on the size of the child
- 2. GIVE 2 RESCUE BREATHS**
  - Head-tilt, chin-lift
  - Pinch nose
  - Give 2 breaths

## INFANT

**STEPS FOR HOW TO PERFORM INFANT CPR (0 - 1 YEAR)**

- 1. GIVE 30 CHEST COMPRESSIONS**
  - Use 2 fingers
  - Push hard, push fast
- 2. GIVE 2 RESCUE BREATHS**
  - Head-tilt, chin-lift
  - Pinch nose
  - Give 2 breaths

## PET

**STEPS FOR HOW TO PERFORM PET CPR**

- 1. CHECK FOR BREATHING AND A PULSE**
  - Check pulse: Artery where your pulse, where it beats. If no pulse, start CPR.
- 2. GIVE 30 CHEST COMPRESSIONS**
  - Use 1 or 2 hands depending on the size of the pet
- 3. IF NO PULSE, START CPR**
  - Give 2 rescue breaths
- 4. RESCUE BREATHS**
  - Head-tilt, chin-lift
  - Pinch nose
  - Give 2 breaths

## ADULT

**STEPS FOR HOW TO HELP A CONSCIOUS CHOKING ADULT**

- 1. GIVE CONTINUOUS ABDOMINAL THRUSTS**
  - Place a fist with the thumb side against the middle of the victim's abdomen, just above the navel
  - Cover your fist with your other hand
- 2. CONTINUE ABDOMINAL THRUSTS UNTIL:**
  - The object is forced out
  - The victim can cough, breathe or breathe
  - The victim becomes unconscious
  - Call 9-1-1 if not alone

## CHILD

**STEPS FOR HOW TO HELP A CONSCIOUS CHOKING CHILD**

- 1. GIVE CONTINUOUS ABDOMINAL THRUSTS**
  - Place a fist with the thumb side against the middle of the child's abdomen, just above the navel
  - Cover your fist with your other hand
- 2. CONTINUE ABDOMINAL THRUSTS UNTIL:**
  - The object is forced out
  - The child can cough, breathe or breathe
  - The child becomes unconscious
  - Call 9-1-1 if not alone

## INFANT

**STEPS FOR HOW TO HELP A CONSCIOUS CHOKING INFANT**

- 1. GIVE 5 BACK BLOWS**
  - Place the infant on your forearm, head down, face down
- 2. GIVE 5 CHEST THRUSTS**
  - Place the infant on your forearm, head up, face up

**★ CONTINUE COMPRESSION OR 30 COMPRESSIONS AND 2 BREATHS UNTIL:**

- The victim begins to breathe
- An AED is ready to use
- A trained rescuer arrives
- You are too exhausted to continue

**Self-Declaration in the Legal Recognition of Gender** Chris Dietz, 2022-10-21 Self Declaration in the Legal Recognition of Gender examines the impact of legislation premised upon the principle of self declaration of legal gender status Existing doctrinal and comparative analyses have tended to come out strongly in favour of or against self declaration This book offers a socio legal alternative which focuses on how self declaration is experienced on an embodied level by trans and gender diverse people It presents research conducted in Denmark which became the first European state to adopt self declaration in June 2014 By analysing Danish law through a Foucauldian framework which brings together socio feminist and trans legal scholarship on embodiment and jurisdiction the book offers the first empirically based and theoretically informed analysis of self declaration It draws upon legal consciousness affect theory vulnerability and governmentality literatures to argue that the jurisdictional boundaries which existed between law and medicine were maintained throughout the reform process This limited the impact of the legislation enabling access to health care to be restricted in the same year in which amending legal gender status was liberalised As the list of states that have adopted self declaration increases this intervention offers activists and policymakers insights which might shape how they respond to similar reform proposals in the future A timely and important assessment this book will appeal to researchers and practitioners working in trans gender feminist legal and socio legal studies

Registry CTR The CTR was constructed by the Center for AMEDD Strategic Studies CASS trauma related information was initially abstracted into it from paper medical records received from trauma nurse coordinators TNCs at Landstuhl Regional Medical Center LRMC in Germany Shortly after the demonstration program started the Army Surgeon General approved its transition to an operational mode leading to the formation of the Joint Theater Trauma System JTTTS and eventually the Joint Trauma System JTS
