a) Write an account of the measures taken by Roosevelt to help the unemployed (15)

One way in which FDR sought to provide immediate relief to unemployed Americans was introducing the Federal Emergency Relief Act (FERA). FERA provided \$500 million in federal grants to state and local governments to fund relief programs for the unemployed. It aimed to address immediate needs, distributing money directly to families and funding public works projects. By 1935, it had provided relief for over 20 million people, showcasing its critical role in reducing widespread suffering as a result of unemployment during the Great Depression.

Next FDR introduced the CCC, an agency which provided jobs to young, unemployed people (16-25) to work on environmental conservation projects, such as reforestation, erosion prevention, and national park improvements. Participants earned \$30 per month, which was sent home to their families. Over its lifetime, the CCC employed 3 million men and planted 3 billion trees, while improving over 800 state parks.

The TVA was designed to regenerate the Tennessee Valley region, which was plagued by poverty and unemployment. It created jobs by building dams for flood control, improving irrigation and agricultural conditions, and providing electricity to millions of people, thus raising living standards.

b) Discuss the impact of the First New Deal (25)


The First New Deal, introduced between 1933 and 1934 had a profound impact on the USA during the Great Depression. Although it did not end the Depression, it succeeded in providing immediate relief to millions of Americans, thus laying the foundations for long term economic recovery. In doing so, the New Deal evidenced to the people of America how vital state intervention was in times of socio-economic turmoil and fundamentally changed both the expectation and role of the Federal Government.

One of the most immediate and visible impacts of the First New Deal was the relief it provided to the unemployed and impoverished. Key agencies like the Federal Emergency Relief Administration (FERA) distributed over \$3 billion to states to fund relief programs, which provided food, clothing, and housing for millions. The Civil Works Administration (CWA) provided short-term jobs to 4 million people during the winter of 1933-34, providing a crucial lifeline for many.
