Printing Religion after the Enlightenment

Timothy Stanley, 2022-07-26 Over the course of the seventeenth to eighteenth centuries an interior private notion of religion gained wide public recognition It then spread through settler colonial contexts around the world It has since been criticized for its abstract immaterial nature as well as its irrelevance to traditions beyond the European context However such critiques
