

writings of Maxine Hong Kingston Amy Tan and Fae Myenne Ng not only complex mother daughter relationships but many faceted relationships to fathers family community and culture Always resisting the simplistic explanations In Her Mother s House brings Asian American women s experience as mothers and daughters to the forefront of gender and ethnicity Female Face of Shame Erica L.
