A consolidating and opening up stage (20-30 generations), 4. A crisis and creativity phase (30-40 generations), 5. An empire and inclusionary phase (40-50 generations), and 6. Renewal or rigidification phase (50-60 generations). Importantly, special attention is given to the often neglected 30th generational period in which an openness to beauty and light prevails. Interestingly, these phases also resonate with the human life cycle. The tour of cultures covered includes ancient Egypt, Israel, Judah, Rome, and the Medieval Modern.
