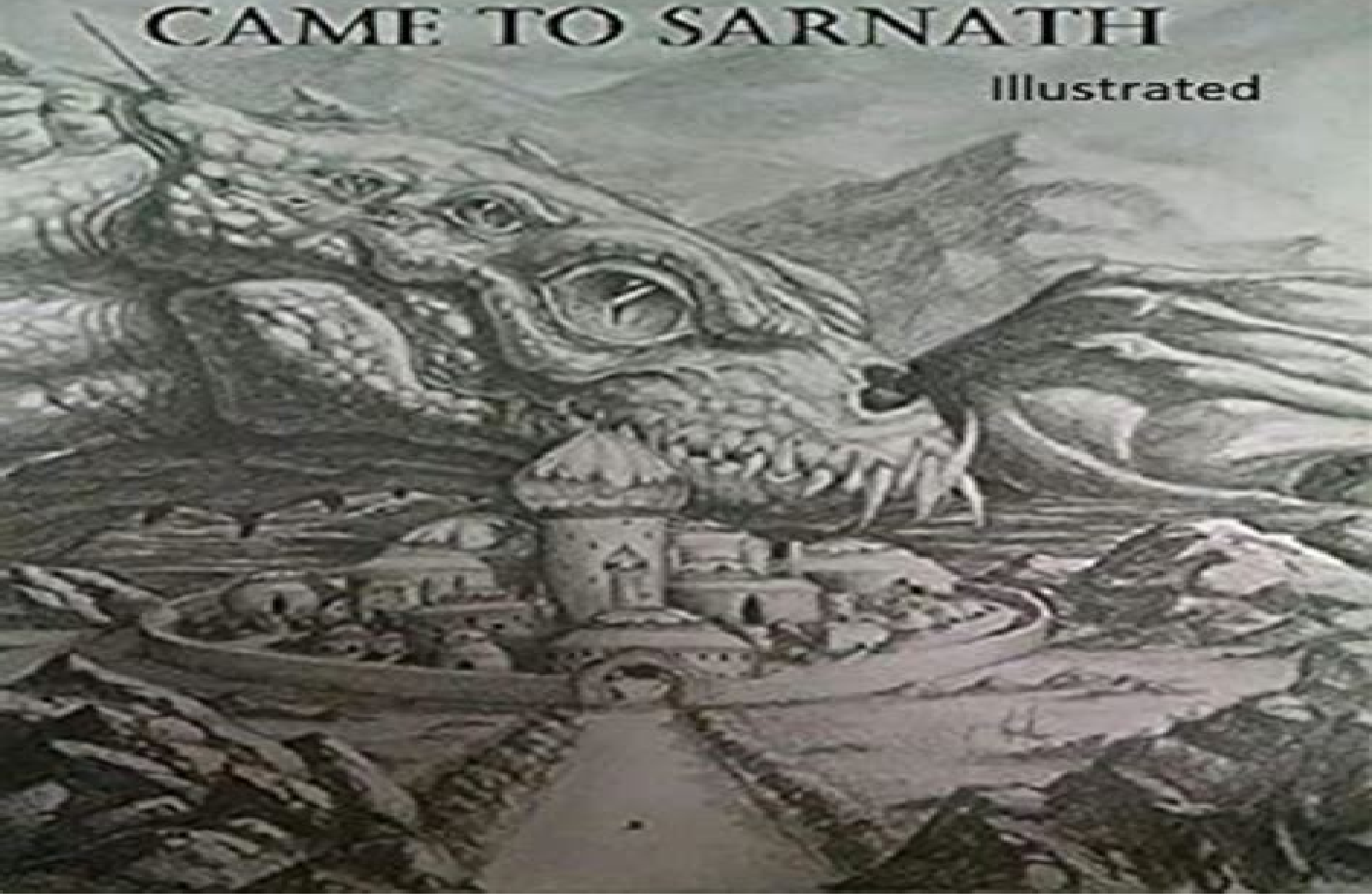

would be both methodologically and practically unsound methodologically for reasons explained in the introduction and practically because it would fail to demonstrate the interconnectedness of Lovecraft's thought and because in Part II I frequently rely upon conceptions expressed throughout the whole of Part I In Part I the author deals with four principal facets of Lovecraft's philosophy metaphysics ethics aesthetics and politics In Part II he studies those same facets as applied to the fiction *Dreamlands* H.
