study then is one of the first to apply some of the contributions of cognitive linguistics to lexicography in general and particularly with reference to the Hebrew Greek and Latin versions of the Bible A further novel contribution of this research is that the meaning is expressed through a definition and not through a list of possible colour terms as happens in dictionaries or in studies referring to colour in antiquity The definition allows us to delve deeper and discover new nuances that enrich the understanding of colour in the three great civilizations involved in our study Israel Greece and Rome
