It's about Time Bill Percy, 2004 It's About Time represents author Bill Percy's attempt to reconcile Christian theology with a more modern understanding of the universe. Not every discussion is as successful; his examination of God's omnipotence is less adequate, ignoring critics who would claim that being all powerful contains inherent contradictions. He has not written a comparative theology but devoted nearly all his attention to core Christian beliefs. It's About Time is not likely to convert many to a theology they don't already share with the author nor does it try to.
