During our last class period on February 2, 2020, I completed the Communication Preference Profile and watched The Power of You, The Power of One presented by Michelle K. Johnston, Ph.D. on June 15, 2017. The profile results indicated I was a People or Relationship Driven communicator. As I communicate professionally in my role, a large portion of my success is the ability to build and maintain quality relationships. In fact, I must pay attention to the emotions and feelings of the clients I serve in order to be effective. These traits serve me well in a professional setting but can sometimes be challenging in personal relationships. In this regard, the results of the profile were not surprising.

Utilizing Strengths to My Advantage Professionally

As a Relationship Driven communicator, it is important that those I communicate with feel heard and also hear what I am communicating. The feeling and emotional state of the message is as important as the words being relayed. Professionally, in dealing with patients and families at the end of life, the unspoken feelings and messages sent and received are as important as the spoken and direct messages. Whether my communication style is a result of my job or my job is a result of my communication style, that is difficult to decipher, but regardless they go together. I pride myself on being able to pick up on the verbal and nonverbal clues easily and quickly. I will often find myself nodding in agreement with a family as to show empathy and understanding, even though the act is largely unconscious. All these traits have served me well in a professional setting as it is important. I establish rapport and a shared understanding quickly.

Understanding Weakness to Improve Personally

While being Relationship Driven in a professional capacity that deals with life challenging situations has served me well, it does not always fare well with personal relationships. I often apply more emotional meaning and feeling than is intended by the sender, or I overanalyze the message. I also have a tendency to dismiss details and facts in exchange for the way I might feel or the way I assume someone else might feel. Assuming the feelings of someone else can be problematic at best. I also have a tendency to see everyone as my "friend," characterizing a relationship with someone as more. Being consciously aware of these weaknesses allow me to shift my communication style to the situation and the person when necessary and can greatly help me improve my personal relationships.
