Transition words are used in a sentence to connect two ideas. They join clauses together to show a difference or a connection.

Example 1: We arrived late at the movie, so we didn't understand the ending.

In Example 1, the word to connects two clauses to show a result. It was <u>because</u> we were late that we didn't understand the ending. The meaning of the two clauses is cleaner than if each stood alone.

Example 2: We arrived late at the movie. We didn't understand the ending.

In Example 2, the two ideas are separate. There is no connection with amiving late and not understanding the movie. Instead, it appears that not understanding the ending has nothing to do with amiving late.
