*Mother Teresa's General Letters to Her Sisters* Kolodiejchuk MC Brian, 2024-06-21 Mother Teresa's General Letters to Her Sisters is a collection of Mother Teresa's circular letters to the members of her religious congregation the Missionaries of Charity Sisters. Not intended for those outside her community they were written informally and spontaneously often with little editing. It was for Mother Teresa a way of being present to the members of her rapidly expanding religious order. Seemingly of little interest except for those to whom they were addressed the letters reveal the spiritual depth and pragmatic leadership of one of the most popular modern saints as well as the inner dynamics underlying one of the most flourishing religious congregations of the last century. At the same time and perhaps surprisingly these letters may also prove to be worthwhile reading for a wider audience. Something of God's wisdom and love seems to shine through Mother Teresa's guidance and counsels giving the reader light and help even though he or she is not living the same religious life as one of the Sisters. Mother Teresa's unpolished statements are at times humble and at times humbling. They inspire confidence and encourage generosity. Many a time they are humorous but more often challenging. They are sprinkled with serene joy but also permeated with deep pain. She delighted in her Sisters' accomplishments yet did not shy away from correcting even the smallest flaw which didn't escape her very observant eye. Sometimes she sounded just like a mother full of tender loving care and at other times more like a commander in chief exhibiting an iron will and uncompromising determination. In either case her followers seemed to have been drawn into the mystery of her charism endeavoring to keep pace with her. Was it the attraction of what could be termed as her leadership style in the unrelenting service of the poorest of the poor or the perceived love of a mother's heart that made her so unanimously loved and admired by the members of her congregation? Or was it both? The letters will reveal the answer. Inspiring in their simplicity the letters may well serve as a treasure trove where anyone from a reflective scholar to a caring mother of a family may find satisfaction for their spiritual palate. The attractiveness of perennial truth often makes Mother Teresa's presentation of traditional spiritual themes likewise relevant for contemporary needs. In the context of Mother Teresa's statement that we are created for greater things to love and to be loved these letters will help the reader discover and experience God's presence through the little miracles of His love in one's daily life. They will inspire us to put our love into living action sharing His love with all those we meet and so make our lives something beautiful for God.

*The Art of the Sister Chapel* Andrew Hottle, 2017-07-05 The Sister Chapel 1974-78 was an important collaborative installation that materialized at the height of the women's art movement. Conceived as a nonhierarchical secular commemoration of female role models The Sister Chapel consisted of an eighteen foot abstract ceiling that hung above a circular arrangement of eleven monumental canvases each depicting the standing figure of a heroic woman. The choice of subject was left entirely to the creator of each work. As a result the paintings formed a visually cohesive group without compromising the individuality of the artists. Contemporary and historical women deities and conceptual

Newell, 2019-04-05 Dear Brother Jane Manning James wrote to Joseph F Smith in 1903 I take this opportunity of writing to ask you if I can get my endowments and also finish the work I have begun for my dead Your sister in the Gospel Jane E James A faithful Latter day Saint since her conversion sixty years earlier James had made this request several times before to no avail and this time she would be just as unsuccessful even though most Latter day Saints were allowed to participate in the endowment ritual in the temple as a matter of course James unlike most Mormons was black For that reason she was barred from performing the temple rituals that Latter day Saints believe are necessary to reach the highest degrees of glory after death A free black woman from Connecticut James positioned herself at the center of LDS history with uncanny precision After her conversion she traveled with her family and other converts from the region to Nauvoo Illinois where the LDS church was then based There she took a job as a servant in the home of Joseph Smith the founder and first prophet of the LDS church When Smith was killed in 1844 Jane found employment as a servant in Brigham Young s home These positions placed Jane in proximity to Mormonism s most powerful figures but did not protect her from the church s racially discriminatory policies Nevertheless she remained a faithful member until her death in 1908 *Your Sister in the Gospel* is the first scholarly biography of Jane Manning James or for that matter any black Mormon Quincy D Newell chronicles the life of this remarkable yet largely unknown figure and reveals why James s story changes our understanding of American history *Polio Wars* Naomi Rogers, 2013-10-18 During World War II polio epidemics in the United States were viewed as the country s other war at home they could be neither predicted nor contained and paralyzed patients faced disability in a world unfriendly to the disabled These realities were exacerbated by the medical community s enforced orthodoxy in treating the disease treatments that generally consisted of ineffective therapies *Polio Wars* is the story of Sister Elizabeth Kenny Sister being a reference to her status as a senior nurse not a religious designation who arrived in the US from Australia in 1940 espousing an unorthodox approach to the treatment of polio Kenny approached the disease as a non neurological affliction championing such novel therapies as hot packs and muscle exercises in place of splinting surgery and immobilization Her care embodied a different style of clinical practice one of optimistic patient centered treatments that gave hope to desperate patients and families The Kenny method initially dismissed by the US medical establishment gained overwhelming support over the ensuing decade including the endorsement of the National Foundation for Infantile Paralysis

today's March of Dimes America's largest disease philanthropy By 1952 a Gallup Poll identified Sister Kenny as most admired woman in America and she went on to serve as an expert witness at Congressional hearings on scientific research a foundation director and the subject of a Hollywood film Kenny breached professional and social mores crafting a public persona that blended Florence Nightingale and Marie Curie By the 1980s following the discovery of the Salk and Sabin vaccines and the March of Dimes withdrawal from polio research most Americans had forgotten polio its therapies and Sister Kenny In examining this historical arc and the public's process of forgetting Naomi Rogers presents Kenny as someone worth remembering Polio Wars recalls both the passion and the practices of clinical care and explores them in their own terms
