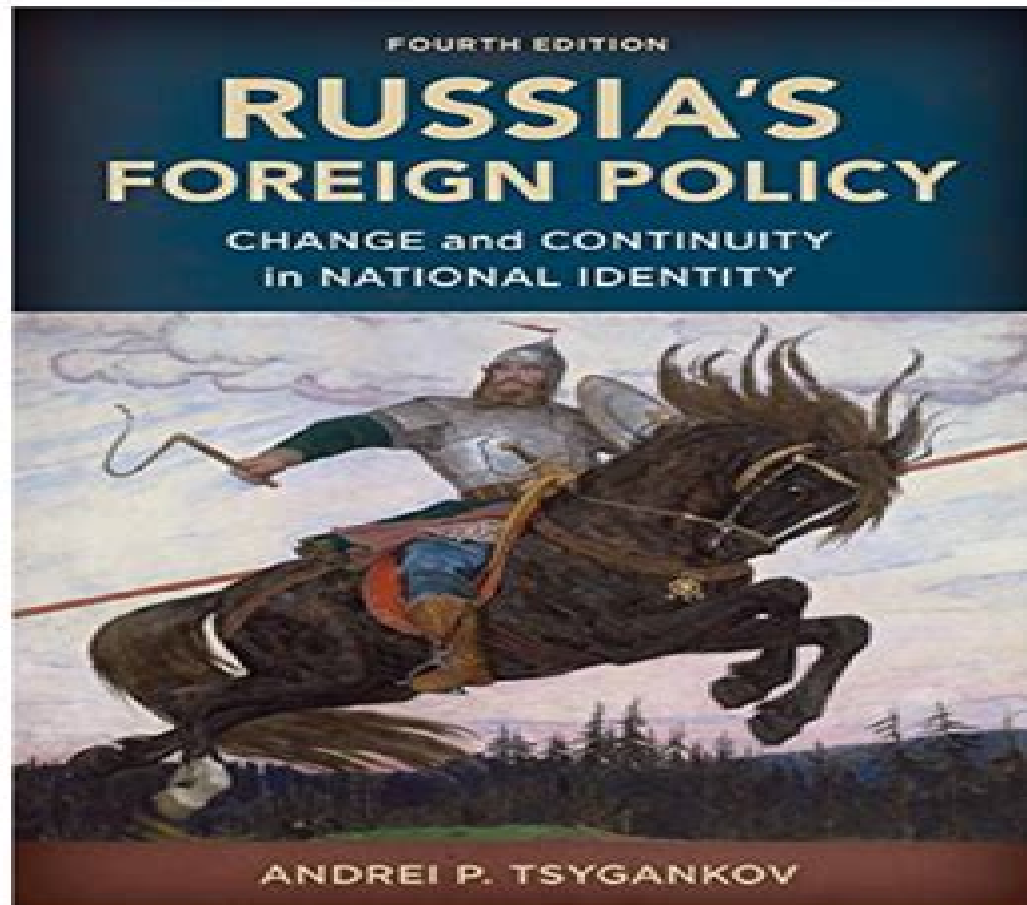

Today, however, the Russian liberal project faces the limits of reform cycles of public administration, suffers from a lack of federalist attitude in politics, and is externally challenged from an illiberal world order. All this asks us to consider what is the likelihood of a reboot of Russian liberalism.
