Pharmacokinetics 5 4 1

- The process of drug movement throughout the body necessary to achieve drug action.
- What the body does to the drug
- Composed of four processes:
 - Absorption
 - 2. Disstribution
 - 3. Arternativolinami
 - 4. Encretion:
- Over absorption
 - The recoverent of the drug into the bloodstream after administration.
 - Approximately 80% of drugs are taken by mouth (enteral).
 - These are the only drugs to pass through the GI tract
 - If or the body to use drugs taken by mouth, a drug in a solid form (e.g., tablet or capsule) must disintegrate into small particles and combine with a liquid to form a solution, a process known as discolution (drugs in a liquid form are already in solution), to be absorbed from the GI tract into the bloods treen.
 - <u>Inhiets are not 100% drug</u>. Filliers and inert substances such as simple symp,
 vegetable gams, aromatic powder, honey, and various elixins called excipients
 are used in drug preparation to allow the drug to take on a particular size and
 shape and to enhance drug dissolution.
 - District agreement Broakdown of oral drug term into small particles.
 - Dissolution Combining small drug particles with liquid to form a solution.
 - The rate if dissolution is the time it takes the drug to disintegrate and dissolve to become available for the body to absorb it.
