Sensori-behavioral based goal ideas:

- Child will improve overall mealtime routine (seated in chair, 20-30 minute meals, actively participating in eating with good behaviors, etc.) as judged by therapist and caregiver report.
- Child will decrease hypersensitivity and aversions to a variety of textures, temperatures, and tastes by tolerating oral sensory and proprioceptive input.
- Child will reduce negative behaviors associated with mealtimes using a variety of behavioral techniques (e.g., visual reinforcements, visual supports, first/then approach, SOS hierarchy, etc.)
- Child will expand food inventory by accepting at least 5 new items from each food group to create a more balanced diet.

Oral-motor based goal ideas:

- · Child will tolerate exercises to improve the strength. coordination, and mobility of the oral musculature of the lips, cheeks, palate, tongue, and jaw. "This goal can be broken down into goals for each oral structure if needed.
- Child will improve drinking skills by demonstrating appropriate use of open and/or straw cup.
- Child will improve chewing skills to a more mature pattern to ensure efficient and safe preparation for the swallow.
