



Enhancing plasma arc penetration ability with radial gas flow

Abstract

Enhancing penetration ability is a critical issue in plasma arc welding (PAW). A novel welding torch is developed to create a secondary compression by adding a radial gas flow below the nozzle of the PAW torch, which acts on the plasma arc in the vertical direction. The role and action mechanism of radial gas is studied by experimental test and simulation calculation. Adding the radial gas will enhance the arc column contraction, resulting in increased arc pressure and voltage; simulation results indicate that the addition of radial gas improves the physical characteristics such as arc plasma velocity, temperature, current density, magnetic flux intensity, and radial Lorentz force when compared with conventional PAW; spot welding proves that the re-constricted plasma arc with radial gas achieves greater penetration depth. These findings suggest that the addition of radial gas flow is an effective method for controlling and improving the penetration ability of the plasma arc.

1 Introduction

Plasma arc welding (PAW) is a widely used and efficient manufacturing method [1]. It has broad applications in the metal welding industry [2, 3] and additive manufacturing [4] [5]. In PAW, a tungsten electrode is enclosed in a water-cooled nozzle, creating a highly constrained arc as the heat source through the combination of mechanical [6], thermal [7], and electromagnetic compression [8]. PAW is particularly suitable for welding medium-thickness plates [9]. During welding, the keyhole effect forms and the workpiece can be fully penetrated through a single pass without a groove [10]. However, maintaining keyhole stability is challenging due to the narrow process window of PAW [11], the arc pressure increases significantly with the welding current, and it will lead to excessive penetration or even burn-through. In addition, it is necessary to further improve the welding performance of PAW in thick plate fields. Therefore, it holds great significance to propose an optimized process based on PAW to increase plasma arc penetration ability and ensure welding process stability.

Researchers have recently made advancements to the plasma arc welding process. The pulse waveform current is employed to dynamically control the keyhole open and close periodically [12]. During the peak current stage, large arc pressure and heat input are generated to melt the workpiece and open the keyhole. A low-level current is applied when the pulse current enters the base phase. The keyhole closes and the weld pool cools down to avoid collapse [13]. The welding process stability is guaranteed but the arc penetration ability is not enhanced. In the field of aluminum alloy welding, variable polarity plasma arc welding (VP-PAW) is proposed to achieve a large penetration depth while removing oxidation film [14], but the penetrated keyhole state is easily out of control. Wu et al. used ultrasonic vibration [15] assistance in PAW to stir the molten pool and obtain finer grains in the weld. However, the welding torch volume and complexity increase, making it less convenient to apply. Various plasma arc hybrid welding methods also have such shortcomings although they combine the advantages of plasma arc and other heat sources to meet manufacturing requirements.

A feasible approach to increase arc penetration ability is to add extra constraints. Liu et al. [[16]] used the magnetic field to constrict the K-TIG arc and realized a larger melting depth, but the magnetic field device was susceptible to high temperatures and increased space occupation. GTAW arc can be constricted by high-frequency pulses to
